10 - 15 of May , Rally Portugal take place after a great return to the north of Portugal in 2015, in the area of Porto.

The first time the rally was held in 1968 and had since 1973 initially for 29 years world championship status. From 2002 to 2006 it was not represented on the World Championship calendar. As of 2007, the WRC moved south to the Algarve. From 2015 back to the north.

Weather

The average weather at this time in the area of Porto is 23 - 25 degrees. A good opportunity for rally, sun and beach.
